What is CPR?

The Trumbauersville CPR program is a research based school-wide positive behavior support system. The goal is to create a safe learning community that promotes student achievement through the consistent practice of compassion, perseverance, and respect.

The CPR program promotes the development of clearly defined and consistent student expectations and accountabilities, communication and collaboration amongst all members of the community, and data-based school-wide behavior supports.

How Will CPR Affect My Child?

Each day at Trumbauersville, students are encouraged to show CPR. Students have received lessons focused on the ideals of showing compassion, perseverance, and respect in all areas of our school. Lessons included

teaching students what these ideals look like in each area and a focus will be on honest self-reflection and setting goals for future behavior. Students will continue to receive these types of lessons throughout the year. Students exhibiting target behaviors will have the opportunity to be awarded a "tiger ticket" to place on the Tiger 200 bulletin board near the lobby of our school.



What is the Tiger 200 Acknowledgement System?

Each day, 10 adults in the school building will receive one Tiger Ticket to give to any student they see exhibiting the behaviors of compassion, perseverance, and/ or respect. Once a student receives a tiger ticket, he or she will go to the office to sign our school celebrity book, pick a number at random for the placement of their ticket on the Tiger 200 board, and will bring home a postcard to show you so that you may share in their good news! Once the student has a ticket on the board, he or she is eligible to receive the "mystery motivator". When ten tickets in a row are up on the board, those students will receive the mystery motivator prize. Examples of motivators are 10-15 minutes of extra recess, lunch with Mr. Schmucker, and there are many more that were chosen by the students.
